

INVITATION TO SUBMIT EXCELLENT CASES FOR THE ISS MEMBERS' MEETING

The International Skeletal Society (ISS) invites members to submit MSK INTERDISCIPLINARY CASES for the ISS Selection Committee to consider for presentation at the following venue:

2026 ISS Members Meeting

October 12-13, 2026

Seoul, Korea

FINAL SUBMISSION DEADLINE DATE: Monday, February 16, 2026, at Noon Eastern Time

There are three (3) parts to submission before a case can be considered by the ISS Case Selection Committee:

1) WHEN YOU PPT IS READY, GENERATE CASE NUMBER AND COMPLETE SUBMISSION ONLINE (CATALYST):

- All started submission cases **MUST** be completed and submitted.
- Each case **MUST** have an ISS member who will be present at the meeting and on the platform for presentation. This member must be listed as the corresponding author.
- Disclosures for ALL authors must be filled out in the submission form before submitting case.
- Please indicate which authors will be presenting and available in Seoul on October 12-13 to present, if this case is selected.
- Each institution can submit as many cases as they would like however each author can only be listed as first author on up to two (2) cases.
- Be sure to have a pathologist, radiologist, surgeon and/or oncologist listed for interdisciplinary presentation. (A presenter should not present another subspecialty to this expert interdisciplinary audience).

2) EMAIL POWERPOINT THE SAME DAY THE CASE IS SUBMITTED TO issmemberscases@gmail.com (see attached template):

- On the first slide include: Catalyst generated case number and diagnosis (this is the only place the top-secret diagnosis is listed---these are unknowns yet all data must be revealed in the PowerPoint to make a diagnosis for the committee selection).
- On the last slide, state why this is a great case for this group of expert MSK physicians.
- Only state the clinicoradiology differential diagnosis, not the pathologic differential diagnosis.
- Please use the new **2026 PowerPoint template and include CATALYST NUMBER (DOWNLOAD PPT)** and make sure it is sent from an email such as gmail or dropbox that is easy to open and not work-security or password-protected and does not time-out.

3) SEND GLASS SLIDES BY FED EX TO THE ADDRESS BELOW (NEEDS TO BE POSTMARKED BY FEBRUARY 2):

- Print first page of online submission form – with Catalyst number, email address, and diagnosis -- and first slide of your PowerPoint.
- Be selective and try to send only one H&E section if it represents a different area of the tumor (i.e. low versus high grade) or a biopsy versus resection, or an early sampling compared to a later one.
- Cut that H&E x 2, add one copy of the IHC (try to limit to the best one or two IHC or take pictures in the powerpoint).
- Mail slides in a hard plastic 5-pack slide container (prefer only one container per case) and use blank white labels for slides and indicate your Online Case Submission Number and label all immunohistochemistry (IHC), to the following address:

SCANNED SLIDE OPTION FOR GLASS SLIDES ONLY

As an alternative to sending glass slides by Fed Ex you can submit anonymized (do not include people or institutions), unknown SCANNED CASE SLIDES.

Submit single scanned H&E slides alone or with rare select IHC. Label these with the last three numbers of the Catalyst submission #. The slide must be covered with a blank label with the Catalyst entire number and the site (or biopsy vs resection) or IHC stain information.

These slides can be submitted in the following formats only: .mrxs, .svs, .afi, .vms, .vmu, .ndpi, .ndpis, .scn, .ome-tiff, .Motic .svs, .vsi, .qptiff, .svslide, .bif, .tif, .czi.

Note: .mrxs files and .vsi files need to be accompanied by a folder with the data. The files need to be compressed with their data files to work.

The only major file type not supported is .isyntax.
