Dr. Yi-Xiang Wang read medicine and trained in diagnostic and interventional radiology in China. He did post-doctoral fellowships in Sheffield, UK, and Rotterdam, the Netherlands. Dr. Wang was with AstraZeneca Pharmaceuticals R&D (UK) as a senior scientist/associate team leader during 2001-2006. He joined the Faculty of Medicine at the Chinese University of Hong Kong in late 2006, where he is currently a professor. Dr Wang is the editor-in-Chief of *Quant Imaging Med Surg* journal, and founder of *Yingran Medicals Co. Ltd* which develops medical image-based diagnostics software and provide consulting for clinical research methodologies. In recent years, his research has focused on three directions: (1) diffusion MRI and new techniques of abdominal MRI; (2) spine degenerative diseases; (3) bone mineral density and osteoporotic fracture. Til now he has published more than 400 research articles, and his works have been widely cited.
